Phil and Joel will be talking about the State of Ignite, followed by discussions on future officers, bylaws, and all of the things Ignite has in

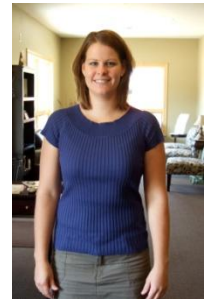
store for it in the next year. (None of the people in the above picture are members of Ignite, but I am sure we will have just as much fun as they were).
